Erie's own Matty B and The Dirty Pickles, will co-headline the 12th Annual Rockabilly Holiday benefit show at Cleveland's, Beachland Ballroom. Along with Pittsburgh's Marauders, the night's proceeds of this all age's event will benefit Cleveland area charities. The Dirty Pickles were offered this night on the strength of their showing when they played with the Misfits at Cleveland's, Peabody's, October 19 of this year.

August 11, of 07, former Erieite and NYC music manager and promoter Kipp Elbaum booked Matty B and The Dirty Pickles, for his annual birthday bash. For the first time since 1983, Kipp held his birthday party in Erie at the Beer Mug, with former X-White Burny White and his band the Mainliners, headlining. From the opening chords, of The Dirty Pickles set, Kipp was mesmerized.

Over the last 20 something years Kipp has worked out of The Big Apple, managing, booking and promoting, bands as diverse as Sylvain Sylvain, Johnny Thunders, Cheetah Chrome, Liberty Devito (drummer from Billy Joel), Stellastar on RCA records and Halestorm on Atlantic records to name just a few.

Kipp's first love and all time favorite band remains Erie's own The X-Whites, who have been split since 1982 although they have reunited from time to time to perform various events for Kipp in Erie. However, the Erie connection remains strong in Kipp's heart. From the opening chords of Matty's set, Kipp was hooked. Kipp returned to Erie to head off to Cleveland for the Pickles, Misfits show, and that was that, he was sold, hook, line and sinker. Matty B and The Dirty Pickles has become Kipp's second favorite band of ALL TIME! Now the story is just beginning.

Matty B and The Dirty Pickles and Kipp Elbaum (rocknrollscene.com) are proud to announce they have come to terms on a management agreement.

Saturday, December 29, Misery Bay and Matty B and The Dirty Pickles will join the stage with the return of Burny White and The Mainliners from NYC, at The Beer Mug, for a holiday show promoted by Kipp Elbaum.

It is time to keep an eye on The Dirty Pickles, January 10 – 13, Matty and the boys via Kipp will head to NYC for five shows in 4 days. Thursday, January 10, The Pickles will co-headline an all star industry show at Club Midway in the heart of New York's, East Village. With them on stage will be NY's, Memphis Morticians, a staple of East Coast Rockabilly/Psychobilly. NYC's Swingin Neckbreakers, performs regularly from Maine to Georgia as well as numerous European tours, and is a NY concert staple as opening act for everyone from The Reverend Horton Heat to Robert Gordon and Southern Culture on The Skids. Filling out the night will be The Public Offenders featuring Dougie Needles, guitar and Enzo, bass from Joan Jett and The Blackhearts. Closing the show will be Thommy Price drummer from Joan Jett, Billy Idol and Scandal, performing songs from his Blackheart Records release "That's Amore".

During their time in NY The Dirty Pickles will also perform at Clifton NJ's, hot new club The Clash Bar, January 11, as well as January 12, in midtown with some of the city's hottest local rock bands at The Mean Fiddler. On Sunday January 13, Matty B and The Dirty Pickles will close their NYC trip with two shows. First at 7:30 they will play Otto's Shrunken Head on East 14th St. a club who boasts a who's who of NY performers on a regular basis including the likes of Lenny Kaye of Patti Smith. On the same night at 10 pm The Dirty Pickles will move their show to Coco66 in Greenpoint Brooklyn, where Burny White and The Mainliners will open and the Hudson Dusters featuring members of The Senders, The Brian Setzer Orchestra, Roy Buchannan and others will take the night out including members of all these bands in an all-star jam.

While in New York representatives of companies as diverse as Labella Guitar Strings, Marshall Amplifiers, Jack Daniels and various Indy Record labels, and other sponsors and investors will be on hand to review these Erie boys for possible business deals.

Elbaum is working on high profile shows including the Coney Island Rockabilly Festival, various summer music festivals, and east coast touring for the spring and summer 08. Kipp is also speaking to investors for a self-produced full length CD for summer release.
